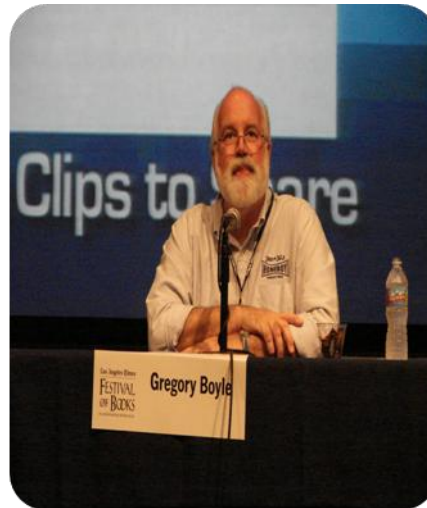

Q What type of event can be held at the Community Center?

You can host a variety of events at the Community Center. From dance classes to scout troop meetings, sports clinics, club meetings and much, much more...

Q Do I need to make a reservation & how long is it good for?

A Yes. In order to insure your groups or event's date and time, you should contact the Marketing Office at the Community Center and request a, "Save the Date." Your reservation is good for two weeks. To confirm the date a deposit must be made within that time, frame otherwise you may forfeit your slot.
