FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q How do I get started?

A Contact the Marketing Department at the Community Center by calling 818-539-0357 for availability and donation opportunities.

(Note, if you are calling to reserve space & are an INCA Parish Group, you must contact Vickie Van Paddenburg at the Incarnation Parish office at 818-242-2579 to reserve your groups date.

Q What type of event can be held at the Community Center?

A You can host a variety of events at the Community Center. From dance classes to scout troop meetings, sports clinics, club meetings and much, much more...

Q Do I need to make a reservation & how long is it good for?

A Yes. In order to insure your group's or event's date and time, you should contact the Marketing Office at the Community Center and request a, "Save the Date." Your reservation is good for two weeks. To confirm the date a deposit must be made within that time, frame otherwise you may forfeit your slot.
