Lenten Season

On Ash Wednesday we begin the Season of Lent, our “communal retreat” for the next 40 days. Lent is marked by two themes: *Baptism and Penance*. During this season

catechumens make their immediate preparation for Baptism. We accompany them by offering our support but also by sharing in their conversion journey. We recall our own baptism and seek to cleanse and purify our minds and hearts so that we may follow Christ more closely . . . that we may become “other Christs” to the world. 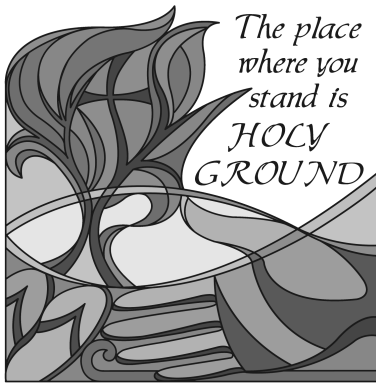

The First Scrutiny

On **Saturday, March 5**, at the **5:30 P.M. Mass**, we celebrate with our *Elect*, the *First Scrutiny*.

For this special Mass we use the cycle A readings.

We hear the Samaritan woman being encountered by Jesus. He discloses to her the depth of the mystery of salvation, symbolized by the life-giving water he promises to give. He then gently confronts her with the secret sin she holds hidden in her heart.

Based on the story of the Samaritan woman, prayers are said over our *Elect*: *Jessica Yi, Melissa Bridge* and *Lasse Glassen*, beseeching God to...

*“protect them from vain reliance on self
and defend them from the power of Satan.”*

In the *Prayer of Exorcism*, we also ask God to give them *“purity of heart and to keep them on the way of salvation.”*

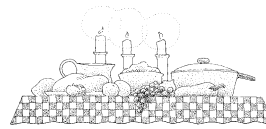

St. Joseph's Table

St. Joseph's Table is a religious custom and tradition that started centuries ago in Sicily. When Sicilians were affected by a severe drought they turned to St. Joseph, the "Foster Father of Jesus and head of the Holy Family," to rescue them by asking him to intercede before God for their cause. An abundance of rain poured over the fields and their crops were saved.

Each March, Italians worldwide celebrate this event with a procession after mass, and a beautifully decorated table with baked goods and Italian food.

Mark your calendars and come join us in this festivity on Sunday, March 14. We will be selling baked goods and religious items. You can also purchase a pasta meal or sausage sandwiches for \$5.
