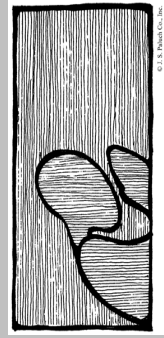

Your prayer may be scripture, a hymn, or just raising your heart and thoughts to God in thanksgiving.
