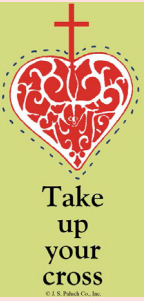

Children's Choir Recruiting



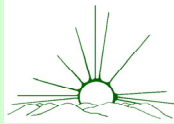
We are looking to add 19 new members to this choir that leads the assembly's singing at the 9 AM Mass.
