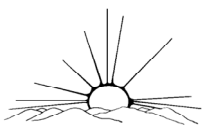
Communion to the Sick & Homebound

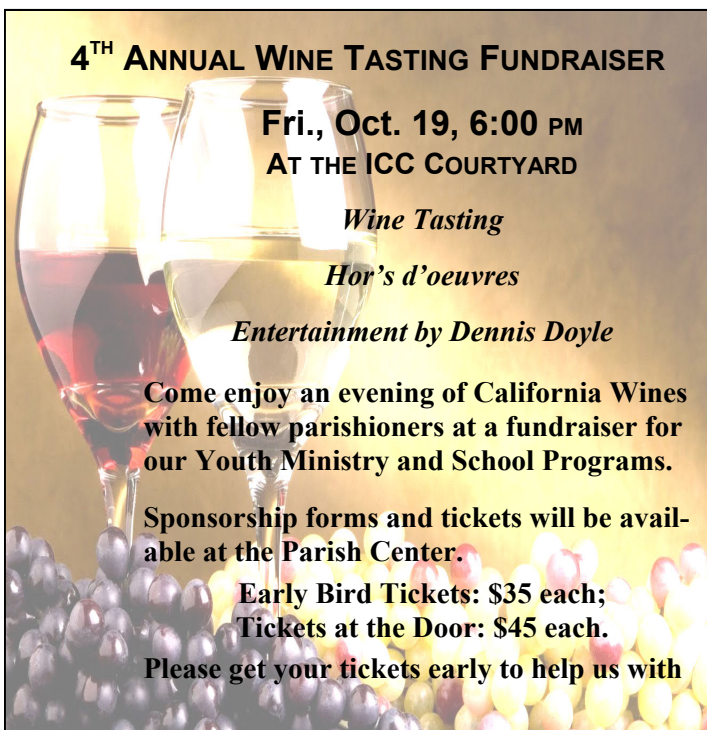

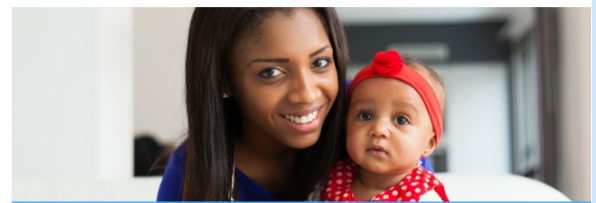
