## All Souls Day is Friday, November 2

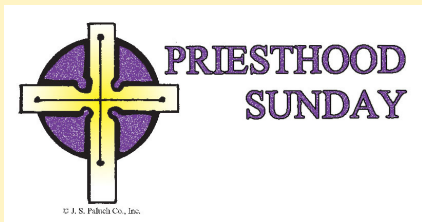
*A Novena of Nine Masses ~ November 2 - 10*

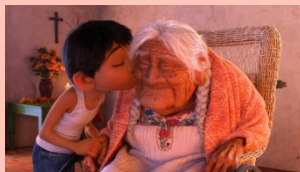
