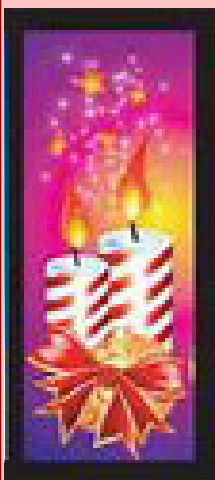

Final Week of the Liturgical Year

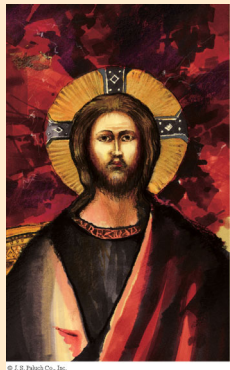


This Sunday we celebrate the **Feast of Christ the King**. Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 in response to the rise of totalitarianism. It celebrates Christ's reign over the human race and human hearts. The feast emphasizes Christ's sovereignty over all creation and looks to his return in glory at the end of time. This same theme is heard at the beginning of Advent.

The Feast of Christ the King is celebrated on the last Sunday of the liturgical year. The following Sunday, this year December 3, is the First Sunday of Advent and begins a new liturgical year for the Church. For the Sunday readings at Mass we begin Cycle C of the Lectionary.

We are planning on running the "Giving Tree" fundraiser this year during the Advent Season. The "Giving Tree" is a Christmas Tree decorated with Christmas Cards in envelopes that will be placed in the Sanctuary. The tree will be available Thanksgiving weekend!

Rice: \$25.00; Beans: \$25.00.

Celebration of Our Lady, The Virgin of Guadalupe

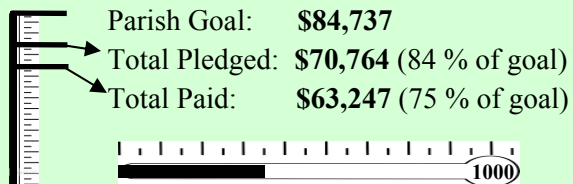
The Archdiocese of Los Angeles will host the 87th annual celebration of the devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe with a Procession and Mass on Sun. Dec. 9. The procession begins at 10:30 am at the corner of Cesar Chavez Ave. and Ford Blvd., close to the 710 Fwy. The procession will end at 1:00 pm at the E. L. A. College Stadium in Monterey Park with a Mass presided by Archbishop Gomez and concelebrated by the auxiliary bishops and priests from throughout the Archdiocese. 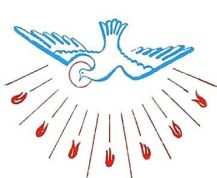
