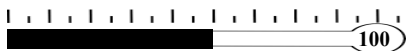

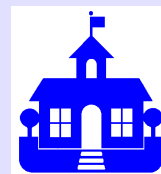

### Announcing: Transitional Kindergarten & Expanded Preschool

We are happy to announce that we will be expanding our curricular program to include a Transitional Kindergarten (TK). Our new TK will be serving 4 year olds on our main campus. Preschool will be expanding to serve bathroom independent children between the ages of 2 ½ and 4 years old. Students need to be 5 years of age by September 1, 2019 in order to apply for Kindergarten (we also have some space in 1st Grade next year).
